

and when the people beheld it, they cried out, "Lord have mercy." It should be noted that after its discovery, a portion of the venerable Cross was taken to Constantinople as a blessing. The rest was left in Jerusalem in the magnificent church built by Saint Helen, until the year 614. At that time, the Persians plundered Palestine and took the Cross to their own country (see Jan. 22, Saint Anastasius the Persian). Late, in the year 628, Emperor Heraclius set out on a military campaign, retrieved the Cross, and after bringing it to Constantinople, himself escorted it back to Jerusalem, where he restored it to its place.



YOUTHBOOK: Let's go to the Liturgy: What do you see? by Amanda Marcus (Author)



<u>Artoclasia</u> is available for purchase to celebrate a name day or special occasion from the Philoptochos Society, **5 loaves for \$50**.


Prosphora & Holy Communion Wine for Memorial are available for purchase **for \$50**.





As we receive the donations, they will be forward to Safe Harbor to continue our commitment to help those facing food insecurity


We are also working with the Kennett Area Community Service Food Cupboard.


